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PREFACE

New Mexico Chapter Laws are numbered in the order in which the Governor signs them.

The Governor has line-item veto power over bills containing appropriations. Partial vetoes are designated by striking through the deleted language.

The designation “CS/” or “FL/” before a bill means “Committee Substitute” or “Floor Substitute” indicating that a House or Senate Committee, or the entire House or Senate during a floor session, passed a rewritten version in place of the original bill.

The effective date of the signed bill is shown at the end of the chapter summary. Unless a specific effective date is listed in the bill, it is effective 90 calendar days after the close of the session (May 21st this year) or, if it is an appropriation, on July 1, the beginning of the new fiscal year. Bills with an emergency clause (*) become effective on the date signed by the Governor.

Proposed Constitutional Amendments (CA) are in the form of joint resolutions passed by both houses and are numbered in order of final passage. They do not require the Governor’s signature, but are enacted if they receive voter approval by a majority vote at a statewide general or special election.

Joint Resolutions and Memorials are expressions of intent and usually request state agencies or committees to perform some task and report back to the Legislature. They have passed both houses, but do not require the Governor’s signature. Memorials are also expressions of intent or request for some action but need only pass the house in which they were introduced. They do not require the Governor’s signature.

All bills that were vetoed by the Governor this year are reported at the end of the Summary. A “pocket veto” designation means the Governor took no action on the bill within the required time limit. This effectively vetoes the measure.

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2014 Summary of New Mexico Laws of Interest to Municipalities

Chapter 5 SB 19

PROHIBIT TEXTING WHILE DRIVING (Wirth). New material prohibits a person from reading or viewing a text message or type on a hand-held mobile communication device for any purpose while driving a motor vehicle, except to summon medical or emergency help or unless the device is an amateur radio and the driver holds a valid amateur radio operator license issued by the Federal Communications Commission; defines driving, hand-held mobile communication device and text message; does not authorize the seizure or forfeiture of a handheld mobile communications device; unless otherwise provided by law, the handheld mobile communication device used in the violation of this law is not subject to search by a law enforcement officer during a traffic stop made pursuant to this section; amends §66-8-116 to create a penalty assessment violation for a first and subsequent offense of texting while driving; first offense is a \$25 fine and subsequent offenses are a \$50 fine. Effective 7/1/14.

Chapter 8 HB 24

GRT: COMMERCIAL OR MILITARY CARRIER (Wooley). Amends §7-9-62.1 to provide for a gross receipts tax deduction for receipts from the sale or from maintenance or refurbishing a commercial or military carrier over 10,000 pounds gross landing weight. Effective 7/1/14.

Chapter 11 *CS/SB 140

TAX INCREMENT DISTRICT BASE-YEARS. New material: prior to revising the base year that the district uses to determine its gross receipts tax increment, the district board shall: 1) adopt a resolution declaring that intent; and 2) no later than 15 days after adopting the resolution, forward copies of the resolution to the Taxation and Revenue Department, the Department of Finance and Administration and the governments that have dedicated a tax increment to the district; the state agencies and governments have 15 days to submit comments to the district; the district must submit the resolution and all comments to the State Board of Finance within 45 days; the Board may approve the revision of the increment: 1) once during the lifetime of the district; 2) if the revised year is a calendar year that is completed; 3) if no gross receipts tax increment bonds have been issued; 4) upon a finding that the revision is reasonable and in the best interest of the state; and 5) if there is no unresolved objection to the revision by the developer or by the local government that has dedicated tax increment to the district. Upon approval of the revision, the district shall: 1) return to the Taxation and Revenue Department any gross receipts tax increment collected between the time the revenue collection began and the beginning of the revised base; 2) update the district tax increment development plan to reflect the revision; and 3) file with the clerk of the governing body that formed the district the revised development plan. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. Effective 3/5/14.

Chapter 13 *HB 12

NMFA PUBLIC PROJECT REVOLVING FUND PROJECTS (Lundstrom). Authorizes the New Mexico Finance Authority to make loans for public projects from the Public Project Revolving Fund for the following municipal projects: **Alamogordo** – building, equipment, infrastructure, debt refinance, road, land acquisition, water, wastewater, water rights, special assessment district and solid waste projects; **Bayard** - building, equipment, infrastructure, debt refinance, road, land acquisition, water, wastewater, water rights and solid waste projects; **Bosque Farms**- building, equipment, infrastructure, debt refinance, road, land acquisition, water, wastewater, water rights and solid waste projects; **Capitan** - building, equipment, infrastructure, debt refinance, road, land acquisition, water, wastewater, water rights and solid waste projects; **Carlsbad** - building, equipment, infrastructure, debt refinance, road, land acquisition, water, wastewater, water rights and solid waste projects; **Chama** - building, equipment, infrastructure, debt refinance, road, land acquisition, water, wastewater, water rights and solid waste projects; **Cimarron** - building, equipment, infrastructure, debt refinance, road, land acquisition, water, wastewater, water rights and solid waste projects; **Cloudcroft** - building, equipment, infrastructure, debt refinance, road, land acquisition, water, wastewater, water rights and solid waste projects; **Clovis** - building, equipment, infrastructure, debt refinance, road, land acquisition, water, wastewater, water rights and solid waste projects; **Columbus** - building, equipment,

CONVENTION CENTER FINANCING ACT DEFINITIONS (Gonzales). Amends §5-13-2; removes from the definition of “convention center” the words “and any facility.” Effective 5/21/14.

Chapter 17
HB 287

FIREFIGHTERS SUPPLEMENTAL BENEFITS (Kane). Amends §10-11B-5 to increase firefighters’ supplemental death benefits from \$50,000 to \$250,000 for surviving spouses or children of a firefighter killed in the line of duty. Effective 7/1/14.

- Chapter 18**
HB 288 **GRT: BIODIESEL TAX DEDUCTION (Gonzales).** Amends §7-13A-5 to provide for a deduction from gross receipts tax for certain biodiesel for subsequent blending or resale by a rack operator. Effective 7/1/14.
- Chapter 19**
HB 14 **GRT: AIRCRAFT PARTS AND MAINTENANCE DEDUCTION (White).** Amends §7-9-62 to allow for a deduction from gross receipts taxes for receipts from selling aircraft parts or maintenance services for aircraft. Effective 7/1/14.
- Chapter 22**
HB 51 **RIGHT TO FARM NUISANCE CHANGES (Herrell).** Amends §47-9-3; any ordinance or resolution of any unit of a local government that makes the operation of any agricultural operation or agricultural facility a nuisance or provides for abatement of it as a nuisance under the circumstances set forth in the section shall not apply when an agricultural operation is located within the corporate limits of any municipality as of April 8, 1981. Effective 5/21/14.
- Chapter 26**
SB 88 **GRT: INFUSION THERAPY AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES (Papen).** New material creates a deduction from gross receipts for the sale or rental of durable medical equipment. Effective 7/1/14.
- Chapter 30**
CS/SB 21 **THEFT OF UTILITY & RAILROAD HARDWARE PENALTY.** New material states any person who by the theft of, or by intentionally damaging, communications or public utility equipment, whether customer- or utility-owned, creates a public safety hazard or causes a disruption of communications services or public utility services to ten or more households, customers or subscribers or causes monetary damage equal to or greater than \$1,000 in value of equipment is guilty of: 1) a misdemeanor for a first and second offense; 2) and a fourth degree felony for a third and subsequent offense; equipment means utility system materials, including transmission towers and associated material, telephone lines, railroad and other industrial safety communication devices or systems, electric towers, electrical transformers, metering equipment, electric grounding wires and electric and natural gas transmission and distribution facilities. Effective 5/21/14.
- Chapter 45**
HB 222 **PUEBLO LEASE OF ADJUDICATED WATER (Gonzales).** Amends §72-6-3 to provide for pueblo lease of adjudicated water rights for a term authorized by federal statute approving a settlement agreement. Effective 5/21/14.
- Chapter 47**
CS/SB 98 **EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE PROVIDER CHECKS.** New material authorizes the Department of Health to obtain criminal history records of applicants and licensees and to exchange fingerprint data directly with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Department of Public Safety and any other law enforcement agency; requires fingerprinting; requires the Secretary of the Department of Health to promulgate rules relating to criminal background checks for applicants and licensees; provides for an appeal if license is denied suspended or revoked; information obtained by the checks is confidential. Effective 7/1/14.
- Chapter 48**
SB 164 **PUEBLO LEASE OF ADJUDICATED WATER (Cisneros).** Same as House Bill 222. Effective 5/21/14.

Chapter 52

SB 31

LOCAL GOVERNMENT PLANNING FUND (Papen). Appropriates \$2 million from the Public Project Revolving Fund to the Local Government Planning Fund to make grants and loans to evaluate the costs of implementing the most feasible alternatives for infrastructure, water or wastewater public projects or to develop water conservation plans, long-term master plans, economic development plans or energy audits and to pay the administrative costs of the Local Government Planning Program. Effective 7/1/14.

Chapter 54

CS/HB 16

LIQUOR TAX DISTRIBUTION TO DWI GRANT FUND. Amends §7-1-6.40 to increase the distribution from the Liquor Excise Tax to the DWI Grant Fund during fiscal years 2016, 2017 and 2018 to 46 percent, then reverts back to 41.5 percent thereafter. Effective 7/1/15.

Chapter 56

HB 32

GRT: DIALYSIS FACILITY DEDUCTION (Gonzales, B.) Amends §7-9-77.1; receipts from payment by the U.S. government or other agency for services provided by a dialysis facility may be deducted from gross receipts in the following manner: from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015 – 33 1/3 percent; from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 – 66 2/3 percent; and after June 30, 2016 – 100 percent; requires annual reporting to the Revenue Stabilization and Tax Policy Committee and Legislative Finance Committee. Effective 7/1/14.

Chapter 58

***HB 273**

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT & PROGRAM (Martinez, K. & Papen). Enacts new material creating the Economic Development Grant Program. The purpose is to provide matching state funds to local and regional economic development agencies to expand the economic development and job-creation capacities of those agencies through employment of economic development professionals. Creates oversight of this program by the Economic Development Commission. Creates the Economic Development Grant Fund and establishes procedures for the funding of an economic development grant. Amends §9-15-11. The Commission shall oversee this grant program by reviewing and approving applications for matching grants and awards grants pursuant to this Act. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. Effective 3/10/14.

Chapter 60

SB 71

MUNICIPAL HOUSING COMMISSIONER APPOINTMENTS (Ortiz y Pino). Amends §3-45-5 to authorize a municipality to create a housing authority as a public body politic and corporate separate from the city; membership shall be by appointment by the mayor of three, five or seven members as follows: at least three commissioners if the municipality, town or county does not contain a metropolitan statistical area as defined by the U.S. Census; or at least five but no more than seven commissioners if the municipality is a city or a county that contains a metropolitan statistical area as defined by the Census; commissioners are to serve staggered terms. Obligations issued by a city that are true loan obligations made to the Farm Service Agency of the U.S. Department of Agriculture or the Department of Housing and Urban Development may bear interest not exceeding par. Effective 7/1/14.

Chapter 67

CS/SB 41

COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE RETESTING. Amends §66-5-60 to provide a commercial driver's license applicant who does not pass the skills test or knowledge test may repeat the knowledge test no more than twice a week and the skills test no more than three times a year. Effective 5/21/14.

Chapter 79 (pv)

***CS/SB 268, 314**

& CS/SB 368

SOLE COMMUNITY PROVIDER FEDERAL COMPLIANCE. Authorizes counties, except Bernalillo and Sandoval Counties, to impose a 1/16th or 1/12th percent gross receipts tax within the county, including within municipal boundaries, to replace funds sent to the Safety Care Pool Fund to be used to obtain federal matching funds for designated hospitals; the tax does not require a referendum. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. Effective 3/10/14.

RESOLUTIONS AND MEMORIALS

- HJM 11** **PROCUREMENT: BID & RFP TRAINING FOR STATE CONTRACTS (Garcia, R.)** Requests the Secretary of General Services to develop guidance and secure qualified training for state employees and local public bodies on bids and requests for proposals for government contracts that will enable fair competition by New Mexico resident business and contractors.
- HM 15** **FORECLOSURE PROCESS TASK FORCE (Chasey & Padilla).** The House of Representatives affirms its commitment to preserving due process rights guaranteed under the Home Loan Protection Act for all New Mexicans threatened with the loss of their homes through foreclosure; requests the United South Broadway Corporation to convene a task force to study the foreclosure process in New Mexico that includes itself and representatives from the following organizations: Tierra del Sol Corporation, the Independent Living Resource Center, the senior citizens law office, the NM Mortgage Finance Authority, representatives of veterans' organizations, a representative from the NM Municipal League or NM Association of Counties, representatives from community banking, the New Mexico Mortgage Lenders Association and other interested mortgage industry stakeholders, the New Mexico Land Title Association, the Consumer Protection Division of the Attorney General's office, a housing counselor, a homeowner and a member of the New Mexico Bar.
- CS/HM 33** **WATER WELL CAPPING TASK FORCE.** Requests the New Mexico Municipal League, the New Mexico Association of Counties, the Office of the State Engineer and the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department to study the feasibility of establishing and strengthening requirements for capping abandoned wells, including both water wells and oil and gas wells, on private and public property; and requests the same groups to make a presentation to the appropriate interim legislative committee regarding the findings from the study by November 1, 2014.
- HM 51** **MUNICIPAL WASTE RECYCLING (Steinborn).** Requests the Environment Department to organize a task force to study the potential of building the recycling capacity of New Mexico's communities statewide.
- HM 61** **PUBLIC FACILITY ENERGY & WATER STUDY (Youngblood).** Requests the Department of Finance and Administration, the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, the General Services Department, the New Mexico Finance Authority, the Public Education Department, the Public School Capital Outlay Council, the Public School Facilities Authority and the Taxation and Revenue Department be requested to form a group chaired by a representative of the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department to make recommendations after a jointly conducted study to: 1) examine and identify the technical expertise, personnel and funding resources necessary to expand and optimize the use of the existing performance contracting and financing tools in the Public Facility Energy Efficiency and Water Conservation Act and the Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Bonding Act to maximize public energy cost savings and water savings; 2) identify what administrative, organizational, procurement, regulatory and jurisdictional barriers currently impede wider implementation of these procurement and financing tools and practices; 3) address public budget process disincentives and outdated procurement practices that slow and prevent wider use of these tools and greater realization of savings; 4) examine successful energy cost-saving and water-saving models in other states, including Colorado and Texas, to see if centralizing technical and procurement expertise as a resource for public entities is the most effective and efficient approach to expanding the successful use of the Public Facility Energy Efficiency and Water Conservation Act and the Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Bonding Act; 5) consult with members of the private sector and the New Mexico chapter of the energy services coalition to identify best practices and fully leverage private expertise toward more public savings; 6) examine the benefits of pre-qualification procurement procedures to ensure that public entities have better access to qualified and reputable energy services companies; 7) make recommendations to address the necessary administrative improvements, resource needs and organizational barriers identified in the study; 8) estimate the comprehensive cost and budget savings from wider implementation of the procurement and financing tools statewide or identify a process to do so and pursue a cost-benefit analysis or identify a process for doing so for wider implementation of the Public Facility Energy Efficiency and

Water Conservation Act and the Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Bonding Act; 9) identify additional public and private grant and incentive funding resources to facilitate and speed implementation of the acts; and 10) make recommendations regarding statutory, regulatory and administrative changes necessary to broaden and accelerate public facility use of the cost-saving, efficiency and water-saving measures in the acts.

- HM 72 LOCATION OF HIGH-POWER TRANSMISSION LINE (Cote).** The United States Department of the Interior Bureau of Land Management be requested to assure the Department of Defense that a high-power transmission line to be built in New Mexico near White Sands missile range will be located along existing transmission and utility corridors so as not to affect our nation's security.
- HM 80 LONG –TERM FOREST & WATERSHED PLAN (Cook).** Requests the New Mexico Legislative Council to direct the appropriate interim committee of the legislature to develop a long-term funding plan for federal, state, local and tribal agencies and diverse stakeholders to cooperate on forest and watershed restoration work in New Mexico; and requests the committee report its recommendations to the full legislature by the convening of the first session of the fifty-second legislature in January 2015.
- HM 82 ALBUQUERQUE INTERNATIONAL DISTRICT (Stapleton).** On the fifth anniversary of the International District, including the area in the city of Albuquerque centered around Louisiana between Central and Zuni, comprising the communities of La Mesa, Trumbull, South San Pedro, Elder Homestead, Fair West and surrounding areas, shall be collectively recognized as the "International District."
- HM 90 AVIATION & AIRPORT BUSINESS IMPACT STUDY (Maestas).** Requests the Department of Transportation's Aviation Division to include an evaluation of how the business climate for New Mexico is affected overall by the condition of and services provided by New Mexico's airports; and requests that the Department of Transportation's Aviation Division, the Economic Development Department and the Tourism Department jointly review the facilities and services provided by New Mexico's airports and provide a report by October 1, 2014 to the appropriate interim legislative committee with recommendations regarding needed investments in New Mexico's airports that would have the greatest impact on improving the business and tourism environment in New Mexico.
- HM 91 IMPORTANCE OF RAILROADS (Maestas).** Requests that the critical role the railroad industry has played in integrating New Mexico into the national marketplace be recognized; and that all New Mexicans be encouraged to grasp the potential that the railroad industry holds for the state's future growth.
- SJR 22 CA: URBAN COUNTIES & COUNTY CHARTERS (Ortiz y Pino).** Proposes to amend Article 10, Section 10 of the New Mexico Constitution to change the voting requirement for authorizing an urban county from a majority of voters to a majority of those voting.
- SJM 4 STUDY STATE BUILDING BROADBAND INFRASTRUCTURE (Candelaria).** Requests a task force study the appropriate role of the state in building broadband infrastructure to provide broadband access to all New Mexicans; members of the task force should include: representatives from the Legislative Finance Committee, a representative of the franchise cable industry and a member of the Department of Information Technology; a member of the Science, Technology and Telecommunications Committee, the New Mexico Finance Authority, rural telephone carriers, members of the wireless industry and experts in broadband technology infrastructure representing the University of New Mexico, New Mexico State University, the New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology and New Mexico Highlands University; the New Mexico Legislative Council is to appoint legislative members of the task force.

- SM 11 FORECLOSURE PROCESS TASKFORCE (Padilla).** Same as HM 15.
- SM 90 ALBUQUERQUE INTERNATIONAL DISTRICT (Keller & Stapleton).** Same as HM 82.
- SM 92 REVIEW NEW MEXICO TELECOMMUNICATIONS STATUTES (Griego).** Requests the New Mexico legislative council to direct the appropriate interim legislative committee to hear testimony and receive recommendations from the public regulation commission, the attorney general and representatives of the telecommunications industry after their cooperative efforts to review and consider modernization and simplification of New Mexico telecommunications statutes.
