Overview

- Gov. Lujan Grisham and NMML will host a summit for local government leaders to come together to discuss how best to use federal money for infrastructure projects across the state.
- The summit will include discussion on a range of infrastructure projects, including water, wastewater, broadband, dams, bridges, and roads.
- Speakers will discuss how best to use American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding, as well as funding available through the bipartisan infrastructure bill.
 - Speakers will include the Governor, cabinet secretaries (Department of Transportation; Department of Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources; Environment Department; Economic Development Department), and the Governor’s advisers on infrastructure, water, and broadband (Mayor Marty Chavez, Mike Hamman, Matt Schmit).
- The summit will provide the opportunity for local leaders to highlight ICIP requests, discuss the life cycle of an infrastructure project, get a deeper understanding of federal funding opportunities, and learn about evolving industry practices.
- An agenda is forthcoming.
